Border-To-Border Trail

The Border-To-Border (B2B) Trail is a long-range plan by Washtenaw County Parks to create a continuous 70-mile network of nonmotorized trails along the Huron River in Washtenaw County from its western to eastern borders. Working in collaboration with communities along the route, two major sections of the planned trail have been completed so far: from Hudson Mills Metropark to Zeeb Road and from Bandemer Park to North Hydro Park. A 0.8-mile section of trail was also completed last fall through Delhi Metropark. Construction will continue this summer on another new section of trail from Zeeb Road to Delhi Metropark.

Hudson Mills Metropark to Zeeb Road

This section of the B2B Trail travels from Hudson Mills Metropark to the city of Dexter and from Dexter-Huron Metropark to Zeeb Road. A half-mile bike/pedestrian route through the city of Dexter (on Central Street) connects one segment of the trail to the other.

The Dexter to Hudson Mills Metropark section is a joy ride through a lush natural setting of woodlands, wetlands, meadows

and gently rolling hills. It includes 4.75 miles of paved path and elevated boardwalks along the west edge of the Huron River and a 3-mile loop around Hudson Mills Metropark. The 2.6-mile trail through Dexter-Huron Metropark to Zeeb Road begins on Central Street at the northeast side of the railroad crossing. This nicely landscaped scenic trail takes you through shady wooded terrain and three bridges over the Huron River. At Dexter-Huron Metropark you'll find a series of picnic areas along the river.

Huron River Water Trail

Recognized as a National Water Trail, the entire Huron River is navigable and accessible, flowing 104 miles from Proud Lake to Lake Erie. The 9.5 mile section of river, from Hudson Mills Metropark to Delhi Metropark, is very scenic and easily accessible with a riverside campground and five nice launches. This section takes about 3.5 hours to paddle at a leisurely pace. Novice paddlers should portage the rapids at Hudson Mills Metropark and Delhi Metropark.
