### Forest Hills Trails

True to their name, the Forest Hills Trails take you on a scenic tour through the rugged ravines, rolling hills, lush woodlands, wetlands and streetscapes of this picturesque community where the great Thornapple River joins forces with the mighty Grand.

This extensive network of nearly 50 miles of paved pedestrian paths, boardwalks and several covered bridges were developed through the cooperative efforts of Ada Township, Cascade Township, Grand Rapids Township and Kent County Parks.

The trails offer stunning views of the community's natural features while connecting local residents with the shopping districts of Ada, Cascade and Knapp's Corner, as well as several township and county parks. The Forest Hills Trails are a great way to explore this scenic area, but be advised that some of the trails, especially along Knapp and Bailey roads, are very hilly and can be a bit challenging.
